Book by One Author Author last name, first name.
Title of the Book. Place of Pub: **Publisher, Copyright Date.**

Boorstin, Daniel J. The Creators: A History of the Heroes of the Imagination. New York: Random House, 1992.

Book with No Author **Title of the Book.** Place of Pub: **Publisher, Copyright Date**

Literary Market Place: The Dictionary of American Book Publishing. 1993 ed. New York: Bowker, 1992.

Article in a Periodical Author last name, first name.
“**Title of the Article,**” **Title of the Periodical.** Date of Periodical: pages.

Trillin, Callvin. “Culture Shopping.” New Yorker February 15, 1993: 43-51

A Signed Article in an Encyclopedia
Author last name, first name. “**Title of the Article.**” **Title of the Encyclopedia.** Publisher: Edition. Date.

Tobias, Richard. “Thurber, James.” Encyclopedia Americana. 1991 ed.

Internet Site Author last name, first name. “**Title of the Article.**” Name of Web Site (Date you visited Site) Web site address

[**Note:** If you do not have an author for the web site, start with the title. In addition, the date in parenthesis is the date you **visited** the site.]
